D. Finance & Facilities

2. **WHEREAS** the Board of Education of the Tarrytown Union Free School District (the “Board”) is considering a license agreement for the parking of not more than 25 school sizes buses at an existing parking lot on the south side of Beekman Avenue between Hudson Street and River Street in the Village of Sleepy Hollow, Westchester County, NY; and

WHEREAS the Board has determined that the Action is an Unlisted Action requiring review under Article 8 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law (“SEQRA”); and

WHEREAS the Board is conducting an uncoordinated review in accordance with section 617.6(b)(4)(i) of the New York State Environmental Quality Review regulations; and

WHEREAS the Board commissioned the preparation of a long Environmental Assessment Form (“EAF”) and supporting land use, storm water quality, traffic, visual, air quality and noise impact studies, and mitigation proposals as necessary; and

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2008, the Board considered the EAF and its supporting studies, and by resolution accepted the document.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

- The Board declares itself Lead Agency for the purposes of SEQRA review of the Action.
 - The Board hereby adopts the attached Determination of Significance and concludes that the Action, as mitigated, will have no significant adverse effects on the environment.
3. RESOLVED: That, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to execute an agreement with the General Motors Corporation, that will permit the use of property bordered by Beekman Avenue, River Street and Hudson Street for the purpose of parking a maximum of 25 school buses, effective August 30, 2008 through August 29, 2009 at a total cost of \$1900.00 in reimbursement of attorney's fees.

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4. **WHEREAS**, it is the plan of a number of PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS, other BOCES organizations, and the Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES (the “BOCES”) during the 2008-2009 school year to bid jointly for the purchase of various types of computers and technology commodities (the “Commodities”); and

WHEREAS, the Union Free School District of the Tarrytowns (“the School District”) is desirous of participating in the joint bidding of the Commodities, as authorized by General Municipal Law, Article 5-G; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education has received and reviewed the Cooperative Bid Procedures (“the Procedures”) governing its rights and responsibilities should it elect to participate in the joint bidding of the Commodities; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby appoints the superintendent or designee to represent it in all matters related above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with Cooperative Bid Procedures the Board of Education agrees to award bid item purchases according to the recommendation of the BOCES if such award is in the best interest of the school district.
