In preparation for the 2007 summer school program, we have attached a description of our course offerings and registration requirements. Our summer school program will run from Monday, July 2nd to Monday, August 13th.

Students not residing within the Tarrytown School District are invited to attend on a tuition basis. Mail in registrations are due by **Friday, June 22, 2007**. Walk-in registration will take place at Washington Irving Elementary School on the following dates and times:

Wednesday, June 27th 8 – 11 am
Thursday, June 28th 12-3 pm.

Directions:

From 287 – Head in the direction of the Tappan Zee Bridge. Exit at exit #9 (last exit before the bridge.) At end of the exit ramp there will be a traffic light, turn left. At the next traffic light make a right onto Broadway (Route 9). Washington Irving School is approximately 1 mile (4 traffic lights) on the left side. W.I. is located on Broadway at the corner of Franklin Street. Parking is permitted across from the school on Broadway during most hours or turn left into the school parking lot.

Coming from North - Take Saw Mill Parkway to Exit 23 – Eastview. After exiting, make a left at the traffic light (Neperan Road). Follow Neperan Road through three stop signs around the Tarrytown Reservoir, past Marymount College on left and Fordham Graduate Center on right. Follow signs for Route 9 (Broadway). Make a left onto Broadway, and follow to Washington Irving on the right of Franklin Street and Broadway.

SUMMER SCHOOL SESSION AND COURSES

The Summer school will be in session four days a week, from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m., Monday through Thursday beginning **July 2nd**. There are two periods of instruction, each period lasts for an hour and a half. All classes will be held in the **Washington Irving Elementary School building**. The courses being offered are:

MAKE CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO THE TARRYTOWN UFSD

1. All students must adhere to the rules and regulations of Tarrytown's Summer School to maintain enrollment. If removed or dropped from a class, tuition paying students will not receive a refund under any circumstances. Students planning to take a vacation between July 2nd and August 13th should not register for summer school.
2. Non-resident students **MUST** have their lab practical scores in order to take the Earth Science exam.
3. Non-resident students **MUST** have their application signed by their principal or guidance counselor in order to take courses or the Regents Exams. Please ensure that the enclosed registration form and all appropriate documentation are complete. Any form without the appropriate signatures will not be accepted. ATTENDANCE

1. Students are expected to attend all 24 days of school.
2. Students absent more than **two (2) school days** have difficulty maintaining a "passing grade."
3. Any unexcused absence or more than two excused absences will result in the student being withdrawn from school.

TARDINESS

1. The school day will start at 8:00 a.m. Any student not **inside** the classroom at that time will be considered tardy. **Remember**, three times late is equal to an unexcused absence.

STUDENT CONDUCT

1. Students are expected to act appropriately, be attentive, show respect for staff and fellow students, follow directions, and complete all assigned class work. **No** discipline problems will be tolerated.
2. Radios, headphones, tape/CD/MP3 players, pagers and cell phones are not permitted during summer school.
3. Smoking is **NOT** permitted.
4. Possession of any illegal substances (including alcohol) or weapons will result in an **immediate dismissal** from summer school.
5. Fighting (including play fighting), threatening/bullying, intimidation, harassment or vandalism will result in a **dismissal** from summer school.

FOOD/DRINKS

1. Food/drinks are **NOT** permitted in the classrooms or hallways.
2. Bottled (plastic) water will be allowed in the classroom, if permitted by the teacher.

DRESS CODE

1. Swimwear, short-shorts/skirts, inappropriate sayings/photos on clothes (e.g. obscenities; promotes drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes), or clothing deemed inappropriate is **NOT** permitted.
2. Students will be required to make the appropriate clothing changes in order to continue in class.
3. Students may not wear hats, bandannas, or other headwear in the building.
