- "Long Term" assignments have been broken down into daily tasks this week. Students may also complete short term tasks posted every other day in Google Classroom, providing your child with ample opportunities to complete each one at their own pace.
- This schedule will fluctuate based on student needs and classroom expectations
- Access to all materials, communication of assignments, collection of work and questions, will be through Google Classroom
- Teachers will post their assignments in Google Classroom the night prior
- Teachers will also provide a time frame in which students may contact them through Google Classroom with any questions or comments about the assignment(s)
- Students have the opportunity to complete their work on different days or combine multiple days into one, and please ensure they are submitting work when it is due
- Our schedule is more of a suggested timeline. Some classes received a packet they are to work on as well.
