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This letter is addressed to the parent, teacher, and employee organizations in the Union Free School District of the Tarrytowns, as required by the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This act requires all schools to inform its employees and building occupants about certain asbestos related activities and records.

Our schools were inspected for asbestos, as required by federal law in 1988. This inspection resulted in the development of an Asbestos Management Plan which was implemented in 1989. The plan calls for reinspection every three years. A reinspection was completed in September 2007 and a visual inspection was done in Spring 2010. The 3-year AHERA reinspection was performed in June 2016 and 6-month visuals will also be scheduled. The results of these inspections as well as the Asbestos Management Plans for each of our schools are available for your inspection in the administrative offices of each school. The master plan for all schools is available in the office of the Director of School Facilities, Operations and Maintenance.

In general, in the school district, we have vinyl asbestos floor tiles in most buildings. In addition, we have asbestos containing thermal systems insulation on pipes, fittings and equipment on several of our heating systems. These materials are mainly in good condition and may remain in place in compliance with federal and state guidelines. Over the years we have abated several areas. All of the asbestos which remains in our schools is surveyed regularly so that it may be maintained in good condition.
