

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF CHILDREN ATTENDING SCHOOLS RECEIVING TITLE 1 FUNDS

In accordance with the provisions of federal and state regulations, school districts must notify parents of students attending schools receiving NCLB Title 1 funds that they have a right to information about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teachers. To comply with this requirement, the following information is being provided with regard to professional and paraprofessional staff.

- All teachers possess the appropriate NY State teacher certification for their teaching assignment
- All teachers possess a Masters Degree in a relevant field or discipline. Specific information regarding degree majors and any other certifications by field or discipline is available upon request by contacting the District Human Resources Office.
- Paraprofessionals provide services to students under teacher supervision. Paraprofessionals possess the required NY State credentials for service as a Teacher Assistant.
- There are no state assessments for students in the K-2 grade ranges that are housed at the John Paulding and Morse Schools.
